

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SELLERS

The Auctioneer has the right at its absolute discretion to refuse entry or participation of anyone to the auction, as well as to withdraw any lot from it at any time.

The Auctioneer has the right not to include in the auction one or more works / objects at his discretion.

Our commission rate is 17% (special deals excluded), to which is added VAT of 24%.

All the items on auction are considered, in good faith by the Auctioneer, to be owned by the seller who also guarantees that they are free from any legal or practical defects and also free from any ownership or interest claims from a third party.

The listed prices of each item are prices of our personal estimation.

The Auctioneer always acts on behalf of the seller. He leads the auction and sets the consecutive biddings of the items being auctioned, reserving the right to reject bids smaller or larger than the starting bid, which he suggests.

The bidding is defined by the Auctioneer, on average 5-10% higher than the last bid. In case there are any disputes as far as the procedure or the final call of a bid are concerned, the Auctioneer is the only judge who will decide whether to finalize the last call or to re-bid the item.

Our clearance takes place within 45 days after the auction. Items not sold at auction remain on our headquarters for 30 days and are available for sale at the starting price. The seller must receive those back maximum 90 days after the end of the auction. After the 90 days there is no claim.

If a seller wishes to withdraw an item prior to the auction, he is obliged to deposit 20% of the average estimation price that is stated in the catalogue.

The acceptance of the above terms is a prerequisite for participation in the auction.
